

LABVIEW USAGE AGREEMENT
Academic/Research Annual Software License Agreement (Campus License)
Student Install Option

- 1) This Academic/Research Annual Software License agreement permits you to install the National Instruments software from the Virginia Tech Network Install Server to be used for academic research and educational purposes. Any form of commercial activity is prohibited. Usage outside the United States is prohibited.
- 2) This software can be installed on one primary machine and one backup machine.
- 3) NI permits you the right to distribute Virtual Instruments (“VI”) and related documentation that you create with the NI software: provided such distribution is for academic purposes. Except for the foregoing limited distribution right, in no case may you distribute software deliverables created with the NI Software without the prior written approval of NI.
- 4) This license may not be assigned, sublicensed, or otherwise transferred.
- 5) The software may not be installed on university owned computers, nor used for internships, co-op assignments, or summer jobs. If you have a need for the software to do work for an internship, co-op assignment, or summer job, a licensed copy of the software must be provided by the company that hired you.
- 6) You agree not to reverse assemble, reverse engineer or decompile the Software or otherwise attempt to access such source code.
- 7) You agree not to make copies of the Software for distribution and will not permit access to the Software by others. You will not reproduce nor permit reproduction of the NI software in any form.
- 8) If you violate the terms of this Agreement, Virginia Tech has the right to take disciplinary action against you and National Instruments has the right to take legal action against you.
- 9) Upon your termination of enrollment at Virginia Tech or Virginia Tech’s decision not to renew its annual NI site license, you will no longer have the ability to obtain license codes for LabVIEW.
- 10) National Instruments and Virginia Tech shall not be liable for any loss or damage arising out of the use of the materials provided under this agreement, whether such loss or damage be direct, indirect, consequential, special or otherwise. Further, National Instruments shall not be obligated to indemnify the user in any manner for any loss, which the user may experience, of any kind or nature, arising out of the use of the material.
- 11) The Software carries an annual expiration date of September 30. Students are required to sign a new usage agreement each year to obtain new license codes.**
